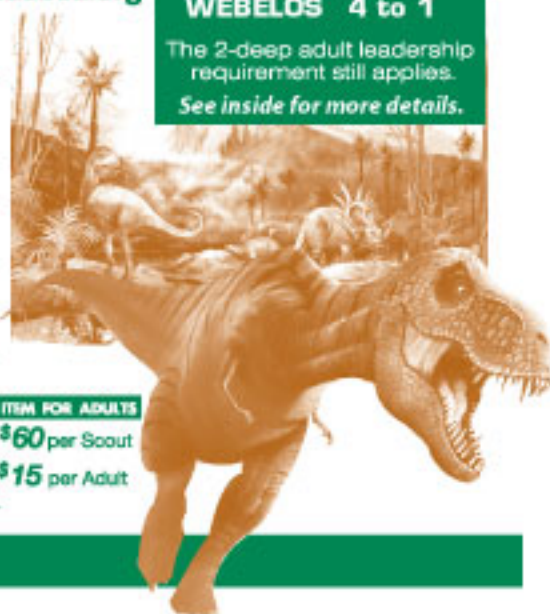

The Youth to Adult ratio for this event is as follows:

**Tigers 1:1**  
**Cubs 3:1**  
**Webelos 4:1**

The two-deep adult leadership requirement for the Pack still applies. What does this mean? One Adult can bring and be responsible for 3 Cubs or 4 Webelos. HOWEVER, Youth Protection rules still apply; Adults are NOT Allowed to Tent with unrelated youth. Unrelated youth may however, tent together.
